Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.210 dated 11.12.2020 registered under Sections 420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals Regulation Act at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in light of previous order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further, the matter stands compromised with the complainant.

State counsel on instructions from HC Gurdeep Singh submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required for further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated

14.10.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
