The instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take legal action against respondents No.5 to 7.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that, in fact, FIR No.50 dated 06.04.2023, under Sections 323/376/506/342/354-B and 365 of the IPC, Police Station Bahin, District Palwal, has already been registered and, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the right of the petitioner to seek protection to the life and liberty is kept open. Needless to say that the State is under obligation to protect the life and liberty of the citizens.
