Petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C, pending trial in case arising out of NCB Crime No.10/2019 dated 17.02.2019 under Sections 8/18 NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station NCB, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, but prays for a direction for expediting the trial, which is pending for last more than three years.

At this stage, learned counsel for the NCB has pointed out that in all there are eleven prosecution witnesses and so far two witnesses have been examined, whereas the examination-in-chief of two more witnesses also stands recorded and the case is coming up for their cross-examination on 07.02.2023.

In view of above limited prayer made by the learned counsel for

the petitioner, the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn, however, it is ordered that the trial Court shall expedite and conclude the trial, preferably within six months.
