1. The petitioner through instant petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') is seeking concession of regular bail in FIR No.393 dated 17.09.2022 under Sections 295, 354-B, 324, 323, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel are *ad idem* that police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. stands filed and co-accused has already been granted anticipatory/regular bail by this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of presentation of challan, he may be permitted to surrender before the Trial Court and Trial Court may be directed to decide his application seeking

regular bail expeditiously and after considering the order passed by this Court in the case of co-accused.

4. Learned State counsel does not object to the prayer of the petitioner.

5. In view of statement made by both sides, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court within 15 days from today and on doing so, the Trial Court shall decide his bail application on the same day and after considering order passed by this Court in the case of co-accused.
