The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Code, is seeking quashing of FIR No.94 dated 28.05.2020 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Shahpur Kandi District Pathankot, under Sections 363 and 366 of IPC, 1860.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, complainant and victim are *ad idem* that victim is staying as duly wedded wife with the petitioner and there is no more dispute between the parties. All the parties pray for quashing of FIR on the basis of amicable settlement of dispute as well for the betterment of the family life of the petitioner and victim.

Learned State counsel submits that State has no objection, if the FIR in question is quashed.

In view of the statement of all the parties, the present petition deserves to be allowed and accordingly allowed.

FIR No.94 dated 28.05.2020 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Shahpur Kandi District Pathankot, under Sections 363 and 366 of IPC, 1860, is hereby quashed.
