1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34 dated 16.02.2023, registered under Section 304 IPC, at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 19.05.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 19.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Swaran Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.05.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
