The instant application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for preponement of the main case from 14.07.2023 to an early date on the ground that the wife of the applicant-petitioner is pregnant of 34 weeks and is stated to be in critical condition. It was also asserted by the counsel for the applicant-petitioner that there is no other family member to support and look after the child after birth, as well.

The State counsel in compliance to the previous order dated 02.05.2023 has produced the statement of Saroj Asha Worker who states that the wife of the petitioner has given a birth to a male child on 23.04.2023 in the Government Hospital Pahari, Rajasthan who has been named as Mohammad Khan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, submits that he does not want to press the petition at this stage however, he prays for grant of interim bail so that he can attend her wife and spare time with the newly born son.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances, the present application is allowed and the main case is taken up for hearing for today itself i.e. 04.05.2023.

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In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances narrated hereinabove, the prayer for grant of interim bail to the petitioner is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is partly allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner be released tomorrow i.e. 05.05.2023 at 10.00 A.M. after producing him before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nuh who shall release him forthwith on furnishing personal/surety bonds with one local surety to its satisfaction.

It is further ordered that the petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Superintendent on completion of two weeks period i.e. on 20.05.2023 by 5.00 P.M.

The petition in the aforesaid terms stands disposed of.
