The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for quashing of impugned order dated 19.10.2021 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana in case FIR No.183 dated 06.10.2015 registered under Sections 324, 427, 452, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest has been issued against the petitioner and later on vide order dated 23.01.2023, the petitioner was declared proclaimed person.

After arguing at length for some time and faced with likely consequences, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to file an application for grant of bail which may be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and on doing so she may file an appropriate application for grant of bail and if any such application filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.
