1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.15 dated 11.03.2023 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

2. Upon instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh, State counsel submits that petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigating agency pursuant to order dated 20.04.2023. Still further, he has categorical instructions to state that no recovery has been effected from him and he has clean antecedents and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Order dated 20.04.2023 is

made absolute, subject to the fulfillment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
