1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17 dated 22.02.2023 registered under Sections 20, 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Talwara, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Vide order dated 17.04.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh, submits that the petitioner is in custody in another case and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.
4. This fact has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
