On 24.05.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for quashing of order dated 06.08.2022 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 15.10.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Khanna, whereby proclamation was issued against the petitioner under Section 82 Cr.P.C. and thereafter, the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person in NACT/322/2020 titled as “Sikander Singh Vs. Gurjeet Singh”, which is complaint dated 22.09.2020, filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harjinder S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1/State, who seeks an accommodation to get instructions in the matter.

List on 20.07.2023.

In the meantime, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply complete copy of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day. ”

The Counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of the aforesaid order the petitioner has surrendered himself before the Trial Court and has since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is expected that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and not absent himself from the proceedings without sufficient cause.
