The present petition has been filed by the petitioner- Kartar Singh under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for extension of parole for another four weeks under the provisions of Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoner's (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 on medical ground.

Short reply dated 17.04.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner was released on parole for 10 weeks and he has to surrender back on 19.04.2023. Along with reply, the respondents have placed on record the medical certificate of the petitioner issued by Amrit Hospital, Pehowa as Annexure R-I. As per the said certificate, the petitioner was admitted on 30.03.2023 and he had stroke with left sided hemiparesis and increase in liver size.

The report (Annexure R-I) shows that the petitioner is required some serious treatment. He has been recommended to take medicine as per Annexure R-II, but it does not say that he cannot be treated in jail.

Hence the ground for extension of parole is not made out and the same is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner that if in future his condition deteriorates, he can make an application for interim bail on medical ground.
