Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the proceedings before the Advisor to the Administrator, is pending for 26.04.2023 on which date, learned counsel for the respondents submits that an application for stay, as has been preferred by the petitioner, would be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of one week. It is made clear that the learned counsel for the petitioner or the petitioner as the case may be, would be bound to appear before the Advisor to the Administrator and put forth the statement. In case the same is not done, it would be open to the Advisor to proceed in the absence of the counsel, to decide the application for stay.

The present petition is disposed of, with an observation that the *status quo* with regard to possession shall be maintained till the decision by the Advisor to the Administrator on the application, as has been preferred by the petitioner alongwith the revision petition.
