Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that briefly, as per the allegations the petitioners along with the co-accused had committed criminal trespass in the shop of the complainant which is situated in the residential premises on 09.03.2023, at 10 P.M. and had inflicted injuries on the person of the complainant, his father, mother and brother. Besides, they had also damaged the household articles and also removed the golden earrings, gold chain of the mother and mobile phone of the complainant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that simple injury has been attributed to petitioner No.1 and no injury has been attributed to petitioner No.2.

5. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application on the score that the occurrence took place at 10 P.M. and 4 persons had sustained injuries. The complainant, his brother Baldev Singh, father Chauhan Singh and mother Baljeet Kaur had sustained 4, 4, 3 and 4 injuries, respectively. Besides, the petitioner and the co-accused had also snatched the golden articles and mobile phone of the complainant.

6. The material on record is indicative of the fact that the petitioners along with the co-accused (who were total 9 in number) were in good strength and had committed house trespass during the night hours. They had inflicted injuries on all the occupants of the house. They had also snatched the mobile phone of the complainant and jewellery of his mother. The petitioners were the members of the unlawful assembly who had inflicted substantial injuries on the person of the complainant and his other family members.

7. Keeping in view the gravity of allegations and circumstances emerging in the case, no exceptional or extra-ordinary circumstances are made out to extend pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

8. Dismissed.
