The petitioner has filed the present (second) petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.208 dated 07.09.2022 registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala.

It is not disputed that the petitioner had already filed first petition bearing No.CRM-M-49890-2022 for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. which was dismissed by this Court by passing a detailed order dated 29.10.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to show as to whether there is any substantial change in the circumstances after rejection of the earlier bail application of the petitioner by this Court on 29.10.2022.

In this view of the matter, this second bail application cannot be entertained by this Court and the same is hereby dismissed.
