The present revision petition is preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate directions to the trial Court to decide the stay application in a time bound manner and till then, the respondents be restrained from making any allotment/allocation of Petrol and Diesel Retail outlet/dealership of oil Company on National Highway No.9 (Hisar-Sirsa Road) under SC/General Category.

On the first date of preliminary hearing, respective counsel had put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 as well as for respondent Nos.2 and 3, on the strength of advance copy supplied to them.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that vide order dated 12.05.2023, the stay application has been decided by the trial Court. A copy of the same has been handed-over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the same.

In light of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
