VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the elected Gram Panchayat of village Bishanpur, Block and District Kapurthala, to function effectively by recognizing the election of petitioner no.1 as authorized Panch to exercise the powers of Sarpanch vide resolution dated 15.11.2022 (Annexure P-3) in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that Sarpanch has gone abroad and petitioner no.1 has been elected as the authorized Panch vide resolution dated 15.11.2022 and has submitted that inspite of the same, petitioner no.1 has not been appointed as the authorized Panch by the authorities till date.

3. Learned State counsel appearing for respondents no.1 to 4, on instructions from Amarjeet Singh, BDPO, has submitted that petitioner no.1 would be appointed as the authorized Panch in view of the resolution dated 15.11.2022, within a period of two weeks from today.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and has prayed that the State be bound by their statement.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the State would be bound by their statement.
