This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 20.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Commissioner, Rupnagar Division, Rupnagar, vide which the revision/appeal filed by the petitioner was dismissed in default and also the order dated 27.01.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Commissioner, Rupnagar Division, Rupnagar, vide which the application filed by the petitioners for restoration has been dismissed.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that against the order passed by the Commissioner, remedy of revision would lie before the Financial Commissioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the above seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy, in accordance with law.
4. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
