Notice of motion.

Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Learned State Counsel has pointed out that warrants of arrest issued for 04.03.2023 were received back unexecuted due to which fresh warrants of arrest were later on issued.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is hereby directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today. On his such surrender, the trial Court shall initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C and after disposing of the same, shall consider the bail petition. Till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C, the petitioner shall not be arrested. If in the meantime on account of issuance of the warrants of arrest against the petitioner, he is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
