VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 25.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2 vide which the matter was remanded to the Collector, Yamuna Nagar to decide the matter afresh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the order of the Financial Commissioner is substantially in favour of the present petitioner and the only issue for which the matter has been remanded is to see as to whether the petitioner will be readily available in the village for day-to-day needs of the villagers, thus, the petitioner seeks

to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to raise all the pleas raised in the present writ petition or available to him before the Collector. It is prayed that the Collector, however, be directed to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from today.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas raised in the present writ petition or available to him before the Collector and the Collector is directed to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of four months from today.

4. Pending application, if any, stand disposed of in view of the above.
