The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.119 dated 28.03.2022 registered under Sections 302/149 IPC at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

By virtue of the order dated 28.02.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Reply by way of affidavit of Satvir Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala dated 03.05.2023 filed in Court is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tek Chand, has submitted that after investigation cancellation report has been prepared and the same has been filed before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate. He submits that notice has already been issued by the learned Magistrate to the complainant and the same is fixed for 26.05.2023 for further consideration.

In view of the above, the order dated 28.02.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
