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VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has assailed the order dated 21.03.2022 passed by the learned Family Court, Ambala vide which maintenance @ Rs.8000/- p.m. has been awarded in favour of the respondent.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the affidavit with regard to assets and liabilities as sought in terms of the order dated May 5, 2022 could not be procured and submitted but contends that as the petitioner was ex parte in the learned Family Court, she may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy as may be available in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
