1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to direct the official respondents to expedite and conclude the investigation in case arising out of FIR No.184 dated 12.07.2021 under Sections 452/323/148/149 of IPC, 1860, and section 325 IPC, 1860 added lateron, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural (P-1) and to direct the official respondents to present a final report of investigation under section 173 Cr.P.C.

2. Pursuant to the notice, a status report by way of an affidavit of Parvesh Chopra, P.P.S, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Atari, Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that after the registration of case, the investigation was commenced by ASI Gurdeep Singh, who

inspected spot of occurrence, prepared rough site plan, recorded statement of the witnesses and even the medical record was taken from the concerned hospital.

4. Learned State counsel further submits that in the present case, Section 325 IPC has already been added by the police. Further, respondent No.5 was ordered to be arrested on 16.04.2023 and has been ordered to be released by the competent court. Apart from that respondents No.6, 9 & 10 were granted concession of pre-arrest bail by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar. He further submits that respondents No.7 & 8 are absconding and every effort is being made to arrest the said accused.

5. Learned State counsel has assured the Court that the investigation in the present case in FIR No.184 dated 12.07.2021 shall be conducted fairly, impartially and expeditiously.

6. In view of the assurance given by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
