1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case which is now stated to be listed for 11.12.2023 to an early date.

2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 11.12.2023 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus

directing the respondents to consider raw marks (and not normalized marks) qua the petitioner (in his reserved category of BC-B) and to grant him consequential benefits accordingly.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State Counsel are ad idem that the issue in question has been decided by the Coordinate Bench of this Court against the petitioner and in favour of the respondents vide judgment dated 11.08.2023 passed in a bunch of writ petitions, lead case of which was CWP-25505-2021 and dismissed the writ petitions and has prayed that the present writ petition may kindly be dismissed in view of the said judgment.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and the fact that the issue in question has already been decided by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide judgment dated 11.08.2023, the present writ petition is also dismissed in the same terms as were passed in the bunch of writ petition, lead case of which was CWP-25505-2021 titled as “Rakesh Sihag Vs. State of Haryana and others”.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
