Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that after the bail granted on 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) he had been regularly appearing before the trial Court. On 19.01.2023, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court having wrongly noted the date leading to the cancellation of his bail and he being summoned through non-bailable warrants.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State and on instructions from ASI Rajwant Singh submits that the petitioner had not absented from proceedings on any earlier occasion.

5. In these circumstances and facts mentioned above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of thereby directing the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within 07 days from today and in that event he is ordered to be admitted to bail to the satisfaction

of the concerned Court. The petitioner shall also furnish the specific undertaking that in future he would regularly appear on each and every date without any default and even in case of urgency he will have to seek permission/exemption from the concerned Court before hand.
