The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is working as Organization Secretary of Shiv Sena Bal Thackray (Shinde Group). He further contends that on different occasions, the petitioner has received threat calls/messages from different organizations and he has annexed the list of names/ Ids/foreign numbers, from which the petitioner is receiving threat calls. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.2, but no action has been taken on the same.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to pass an appropriate orders in accordance with law.
