This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order/notices dated 13.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.6; impugned notices dated 19.11.2019 (Annexures P-3, P-4, P-5 & P-6) issued under Section 24(1) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, issued by respondent No.4 and impugned notice issued under Section 24(2) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act dated 29.11.2019 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.7.

2. On 28.04.2023, this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

“Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, notices have been issued under Sections 24(1) and 24(2) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act and the petitioners have an alternative remedy under Section 28 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act.
