Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that private respondents No. 5 to 9 had caused injuries after trespassing in their house. MLR was also recorded and the matter was reported to the police but no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that even application/representation dated 22.03.2023 and 10.04.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), respectively, have also been moved before respondent No.2 but no action thereon has been taken.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.

In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to
