VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioners are seeking to quash FIR No.91 dated 05.12.2014 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur and also to set aside the judgment and order of sentence dated 25.02.2019 on the basis of compromise.
2. Initially, the parties were directed to get the statements recorded in terms of order dated 22.08.2022. However, the complainant had not appeared before the concerned Court to get the statement recorded.
3. Thereafter, another opportunity was granted to get the statement of respondent No.2 recorded before the learned Magistrate.
4. As per the report, the respondent No.2 had appeared and made a statement in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class that she does not want to give statement as per compromise dated 06.12.2021.
5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the Court afresh at a subsequent stage, if any compromise effected.
6. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
