Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short the Cr.P.C.) for issuing direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to present the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., before the Illaqa Magistrate in case FIR No.0087 dated 09.05.2017, under Section 452, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'the IPC') (and Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.
