Learned State counsel has placed on record the copy of judgment dated 16.11.2021 passed in criminal case bearing FIR No. 89, dated 18.06.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 365, 506, 341, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.
