This is an application under Section 151 CPC for an early hearing of the main petition, which is fixed for hearing on 06.04.2023.

Notice in the application.

Learned State counsel submit that they have no objection, if the present application is allowed.

In view of the above, the present application is allowed and date of hearing of the main petition is preponed from 06.04.2023 to that of today and the same is taken on the Board for hearing.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide letter dated 13.02.2023, Principal, Govt. Industrial Training Institute, Gohana,

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has given one month's advance notice for termination of service agreement of the petitioner, and that the petitioner wants to challenge the aforesaid letter dated 13.02.2023 as per law.

Learned State counsel submits that a similar controversy came up before this Court in CWP-4881-2023, which stood dismissed on 13.03.2023. This aforementioned position has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner. A relevant extract of the order dated 13.03.2023 passed in CWP-4881-2023 would read as under:

“As one month’s notice dated 13.02.2023 (Annexure P-14) for termination of services has been issued to the petitioner, who are the contractual employees, in compliance of the order dated 10.09.2021 passed in CWP-35305-2019 and the order dated 08.10.2021 passed by Hon’ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 15629-15631/2021, no case to grant the relief to the petitioner as sought for, is made out.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.

Liberty is grated to the petitioner to reply to the notice dated 13.02.2023 (Annexure P-14).”

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to challenge the letter dated 13.02.2023 as per law.
