1. This is the petitioner's third attempt to get the bail during the pendency of the trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.132, dated 30.12.2017, registered under Section 302/458 and 34 IPC and Section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 182, 211 and 120-B IPC added and Section 458 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 deleted subsequently), at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

2. During the investigation, it came to the notice of the prosecution that the petitioner after murdering his own father tried to falsely implicate various persons with whom he had a criminal case. The police after investigation unearthed the conspiracy and arrested the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of more than 4 years and the court while granting bail is not required to take into consideration the antecedents of the petitioner.

4. This court has considered the submission of the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

5. As per the status report filed by the prosecution, the petitioner apart from FIR No.132 dated 30.12.2017, is also accused in the following cases:-

6. In the considered opinion of the court, while considering the request for the grant of concession of bail, the court cannot overlook the

antecedents of the petitioner which are of some significance.

7. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.
