Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of direction to official respondents to conduct investigation upon the representation dated 16.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner and to take remedial action against respondents No.6 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner was married with respondent No.6 but thereafter, her parents had forcibly taken her away from the company of petitioner. He submits that the petitioner had an apprehension that the parents would marry respondent No.6 with some one else. He further submits that petitioner has filed the representation but there was no action taken by respondent No.4 on the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has submitted that as per averments made in the representation, respondent No.6 is

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already married with some other boy.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the contention raised by counsel for the petitioner is that he was the first husband of respondent No.6. However, without any divorce, her parents had married her with some other boy.

In the facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedies as available to him under the law.
