Learned counsel for the petitioner has impugned the directions given by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Fazilka vide order dated 12.01.2023 (Annexure P-2) regarding deposit of 20% of the compensation amount as awarded by learned trial Court to the appellant within 60 days from the date of passing of the order.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not dispute any infirmity in the impugned order and the petitioner would be satisfied if some more time is granted to him to comply with the directions to deposit 20% of the compensation amount.

3. Perusal of the record shows that there is no infirmity in the impugned order so as to call for interference of this Court, however, keeping in view the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner and in the interest of justice, petitioner is granted 30 days time from today to comply with the directions given vide impugned order to deposit 20% of the compensation amount to the appellant.

4. The petition is disposed of with aforesaid directions.
