On 27.04.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

‘The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 03.04.2023 passed by the Additional sessions Judge, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) in case NDPS/842/2019 dated 04.10.2019 titled as ‘State versus Deepak Puri and ors.’ arising out of FIR No.38 dated 01.08.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Patara, District Jalandhar whereby non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of a medical emergency, the petitioner was unable to appear on one date i.e. 03.04.2023, on which date, the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Association for Children with Type 1 Diabetes, SCO 24, Sector 23-C, Chandigarh, A/C No.37187322216 (SBI), he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the JSC, Jalandhar, and has since been admitted to interim bail as is borne out from the order dated 19.05.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
