Gurpreet Singh and Harshdeep Kaur have filed civil revision under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside impugned order dated 24.03.2023 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Sangrur, whereby the said Court declined the application for waiving off the statutory period of one year for filing the petition seeking divorce under the provisions of Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act being pre-mature in view of the provisions of Section 14 of the Hindu Marriage Act. The copy of impugned order dated 24.03.2023 is Annexure P-2.

As per order dated 24.03.2023, the original petition along with documents if any was ordered to be returned to the parties after retaining copies of the same. The perusal of said impugned order shows that the petitioners got married on 03.10.2022. Now, the period of one year has already lapsed. Therefore, the present civil revision preferred by the petitioners against impugned order dated 24.03.2023 has become infructuous, as the petitioners can always file their petition under the provisions of 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, if they so desire.
