Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that FIR No.0502 dated 27.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) registered under Sections 379, 447 and 506 of IPC, P.S. Rania, District Sirsa, was registered only after the intervention of this Court but still the respondent No.4 is not taking any action thereon and in this regard representation dated 01.06.2022 (Annexure P-7) was moved to respondent No.3- The Superintendent of Police, District Sirsa and thereafter the petitioner has also moved representations dated 30.11.2022 and 21.03.2023, but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vishal Malik, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State..

The copies of representation dated 30.11.2022 and 21.03.2023

have been supplied to learned State counsel.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3- The Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representations 30.11.2022 and 21.03.2023 expeditiously in accordance with law and take action thereon, if so, warranted. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner.

It is, however, made clear that any observation made above shall not affect the merits of the case nor the same will influence the concerned authority in deciding the representations in accordance with law.

Disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
