Application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act read with

Section 482 Cr.PC for condonation of delay of 371 days in filing the present appeal has been filed.

CRA-S-801-2022

The instant appeal has been filed under Section 14-A of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the order dated 16.03.2019 wherein the anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC has been declined by the learned Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 17.05.2022, interim relief in the same terms as passed in CRA-S-717-2022, was granted and the appellant was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that pursuant to order dated 17.05.2022, appellant has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the appellant has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 17.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section

438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present appeal stands disposed off.
