Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner had business dealings with the respondent No.4 and during the same, three cheques were given towards security to respondent No.4 which he is now threatening to misuse and also threatened to harm the petitioners physically regarding which representation (Annexure P-3) dated 25.01.2023 was given to respondent No.3- S.H.O., Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, but no action was taken. He submits that aggrieved by the conduct, the petitioner has moved representation (Annexure P-4) dated 28.02.2023 to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, but no action thereof has been taken.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG,

Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3.

Without commenting on merits on the allegations, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, to decide the representation dated 28.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously in accordance with law and the decision, so taken, be also conveyed to the petitioner.
