The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.02 dated 27.11.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Punjab State Crime Police Station, SAS Nagar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
