1. Status report by way of an affidavit of Superintendent of Police, (INV), GRP Ludhaina has been filed on behalf of State-respondent, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.
2. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-
