Petitioner has filed the above mentioned petitions separately for grant of anticipatory bail as well as quashing of order dated 23.11.2019 passed by JMIC, Dhuri in case FIR No.04 dated 12.01.2018 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, whereby she was declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh,

has stated that in the subject FIR bearing No.04 dated 12.01.2018, registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, Punjab, the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 23.11.2019, but pursuant to the interim order dated 27.04.2023 passed in CRM-M-14987-2023, she appeared before the trial Court on 05.05.2023, and subsequently, the trial in the impugned FIR, ended in her acquittal vide judgment dated 08.06.2023.

The above position is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
