1. The petitioner herein seeks directions to the respondents to regularize his services as Mechanical Helper w.e.f. 01.10.2003 instead of 22.08.2014 as he fulfills all the conditions for regularization laid down in the policy of 2003, and also release the consequential benefits.
2. At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his legal notice dated 16.11.2022 Annexure P-9, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, is decided by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
5. Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

6. Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide legal notice dated 16.11.2022 Annexure P-9 by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
