The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.178 dated 07.08.2021 registered under Sections 379-B, 411, 201/34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City.

As per the allegations of the FIR, three persons riding a bike snatched mobile phone of complainant Ritik Kumar on 07.08.2021. He could not notice the registration number of the motorcycle on which the snatchers had come.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

On instructions from ASI Hardeep Kumar, it is stated by learned State counsel that recovery of the snatched mobile was effected from co-accused Gurjinder Singh.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for last 7 months and 20 days, and one

more criminal case arising out of FIR No.240 dated 31.08.2022 is pending against him.

Having regard to the fact that no recovery is effected from the petitioner in this case and trial may take time to conclude, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
