Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation to senior officer and to constitute SIT for getting the fair investigation in FIR No.0040 dated 12.03.2020 lodged for offences under Sections 21, 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, Section 3 of the Indian Passport Act, 1920 and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.
