The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to look into the complaint/representation of the petitioner and take an appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 15.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that daughter of the petitioner got married with Maninder Singh son of Rajinder Singh on 05.05.2022. The petitioner had spent money on the occasion of marriage as per his capacity. The private respondents are harassing his daughter and have thrown her out of matrimonial home. The petitioner has moved representation to official respondents to take an appropriate action against private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab, who on advance notice, is present in Court, accepts notice and assures the Court that jurisdictional police authorities would look into the representation of the petitioner and do the needful.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, this Court is sanguine of the fact that jurisdictional authorities would look into the representation of the petitioner and do the needful in accordance with law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
