1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0018 dated 17.02.2017, registered for offences under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 17.01.2023, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
2. As per report received from the Trial Court, parties have not appeared for recording of their statements.
3. There is no representation on behalf of either of the parties.
4. Similar was the position on the previous occasion.
5. It seems that as the compromise probably could not be given effect to that is why the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter.
6. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
