The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.274 dated 28.06.2013 (Annexure P-1/T) under Section 135 of Electricity Act registered at Police Station Anti Power Theft Verka, Amritsar, District Amritsar and consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount due towards the petitioner as on today is Rs.99,211/- and he is ready and willing to make the payment of the same.

The Counsel for the respondent no.2 submits that on receipt of the said amount the offence can be compounded.

In view of the above, if a settlement is arrived at between the

parties, they are at liberty to move an appropriate application before the Illaqa Magistrate to compound the offence.
