Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a detailed and fair inquiry on his complaint/application/representation dated 17.05.2018, which is annexed as Annexure P-5 moved for initiating action against the private respondents, who had allegedly committed fraud with the petitioner with respect to the purchase of some property.

Learned State counsel submits that the Investigating Agency found no substance in the allegations of cheating levelled by the petitioner against private respondents. Learned State further submits that the petitioner has already instituted a complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel and the reply filed by him, no ground is made out for issuance of

directions as prayed for.
